Key Responsibilities:

This full-time, non-exempt position reports to the Quality Improvement Manager in the Learning Institute.

The Child Care Workforce Development Coordinator is responsible for the development and implementation of training for various grants administered through CocoKids while working in partnership with the community to elevate the child care workforce.

- Collaborate with community agencies to develop a robust annual training calendar for family child care providers, center staff and family, friend and neighbor (FFN) caregivers
- Provide and coordinate logistical support for virtual and face to face trainings
- Create and/or acquire training procedure manuals, guides, and course materials, develop and teach workshops
- Present training and development programs using various forms and formats including group discussion, lecture, simulations, and videos
- Research and implement innovative training strategies
- Ensure training opportunities contribute to the growth of the local workforce and child care slots, track and report on statistics, apply feedback & analysis to improve
- Maintain & develop monthly E-newsletter (training links, description of training, additional resources, highlight of departments and services, etc.)
- Maintain knowledge of the latest trends in training and development

- Minimum of three years' work experience in child care or related field required
- Experience training large groups in a variety of settings
