Qualifications:

- High School diploma or equivalent required; Associate's degree preferred.
- Must currently hold or qualify for a Child Development Teacher Permit issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC).
- Completion of at least six (6) semester units specifically in Infant/Toddler coursework.
- One-year work or volunteer experience in an infant/toddler care setting.
- Be willing to participate in the program for Infant/Toddler Caregivers training.
- Ability to frequently lift and/or move 10–30 pounds and occasionally lift up to 50 pounds.
- Valid California driver license and insured reliable transportation.

Responsibilities:

- Provide high-quality care and supervision to assigned infants and toddlers as their primary caregiver.
- Develop warm, nurturing relationships with children to foster a secure and supportive learning environment
- Conduct ongoing observations to complete comprehensive developmental assessments.
- Utilize assessment data to create weekly lesson plans tailored to support each child's individual developmental goals.
- Assist in maintaining a healthy, attractive, and engaging classroom environment.
- Keep parents well-informed regarding their child's daily activities, progress, and well-being.
- Provide consistent information about program services while actively seeking input from parents regarding their home culture and values.
- Provide childcare for center parent meetings and other program activities as assigned.
- Participate in scheduled meetings and conferences as assigned.
