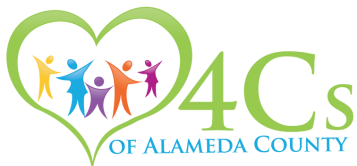

## Community Services

**874** child care providers received technical assistance and support

**1,657** child care directors, business owners, teachers, and caregivers attended **82** different trainings, workshops, listening sessions, and Provider Cafes

**8,965** child care resources and referrals were given to parents helping them to navigate and find child care options for their children

**853** parents attended **70** different trainings, workshops, playgroups, and Parent Cafes hosted by 4Cs



4Cs hosted **42** Play & Learn playgroups with **90** toddlers growing, learning and playing alongside their caregivers

Family Navigators supported community members with supports for **308** community members caring for children:

- In need of inclusion services
- Living in unincorporated Alameda County
- part of the Foster Care system
- In the Downtown Hayward Promise Neighborhood footprint

## Child Care Payment Assistance Programs



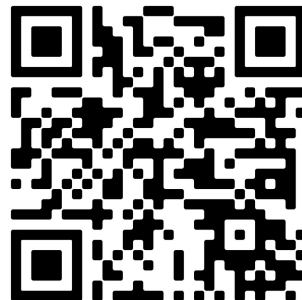
**5,096,238,509,6238** hours (or **33,997** months) of child care were provided to families resulting in **\$36,009,429.87** in payments to child care providers to cover the cost of providing care for **3,473** children.

## Events & Distributions

**417,640** diapers were provided to 4Cs families

**4,000** children's books were distributed to young learners

**75,449** pounds of food were provided to families and community members through 4Cs food distribution events and the RISE Resource Center

## Agency Growth

**\$48,225,910** in revenue with 80% distributed to child care providers caring for children on 4Cs child care payment programs

**80** staff members and **3** interns who speak **17** different languages
