OUR MISSION: 4Cs connects and empowers families, educators, and child care providers with resources today for a stronger San Mateo County tomorrow.

OUR SERVICE AREAS:

Parents & Families

As the only Child Care Resource and Referral Agency (R&R) in San Mateo County, we provide free referrals to child care and early education programs that meets families' needs, child care subsidies to low income families, and free and low-cost education and workshops for families. Additionally, we provide parents of children with special needs with enhanced referrals for child care.

Early Childhood Education (ECE) Providers

We train child care providers in child development, nutrition, preventative health, and CPR/1st Aid. Center, home-based, and license-exempt child care providers can access our technical assistance and business development services, as well as receive referrals to their programs.

Leadership & Advocacy

In addition to implementing the county's programs that assess & improve the quality of child care programs, 4Cs works with community partners, and policymakers on early childhood initiatives and advocacy issues. We maintain data on child care supply and demand which are analyzed for local needs assessments, supply mapping, and understanding the economic impact of child care in our County.

CHANGE MAKERS



- ✦ 680 families and 1,105 children received subsidies to help pay for child care
- ✦ 3,128 parents and guardians were given free resource and child care referrals, either online or by phone
- ✦ 40 enhanced referrals were fulfilled for families with children who have special needs
- ✦ 99 workshops, trainings, and information sessions were provided to parents and providers
- ✦ 1,850 one-on-one technical assistance/coaching sessions were offered to parents and providers
- ✦ 419 early care and education providers participated in professional development activities to increase the quality of their care
- ✦ 68 providers took part in our Quality Counts Program, improving the quality of their care and participating in the largest cohort in the history of the program in San Mateo County
