## Child Care & Family Resources

### Alternative Payment Program (AP)

FCCHEN and Early Head Start Partnership providers offer high quality childcare to eligible families. Parents are able to work or study while their children learn in a safe environment.

### Licensed Child Care Referrals

Free childcare referrals for parents to local Child Care Centers & Licensed Family Child Care Homes in the area

## Education

### Resource & Referral Program (R&R)

Parent Advisory Committee meetings quarterly for all parents to discuss needs of childcare in the county

### Lending Library

Welcome Baby Program in collaboration with First 5 Trinity, helps new families with child development and health resources and needs in their first year of parenting

## Health, Safety, & Nutrition

### Child Care Food Program

A USDA Program that reimburses Child Care Providers for the healthy meals they serve to the children in their care

### Trustline & Live Scan Fingerprint Services

Background checks and fingerprint services are available to local Child Care Providers, and families to help with licensing and TrustLine applications.

### EMSA Certified Preventative Health & Safety

We host the EMSA Certified Preventative Health and Safety course required for participants who are looking to obtain a Child Care License
