### Child Care & Family Resources

#### Alternative Payment Program (AP)

Provides flexible vouchers that make child care affordable - Allowing parents to work or study, while their children learn in a safe environment

#### Eligibility List (CEL) for Lake County

Our waitlist helps assess each family's need for AP Program, and keeps families up-to-date on their position on the Eligibility List

#### Emergency Child Care Bridge Program

Support families caring for children in foster care with trauma-informed child care choices

#### Licensed Child Care Referrals

Free childcare referrals for parents to local Child Care Centers & Licensed Family Child Care Homes in the area

### Education

#### Resource & Referral Program (R&R)

R&R provides free resources and child care referrals to local Child Care Providers, plus education on the local child care issues

Borrow educational and books & curriculum for your family or Child Care business - For free!

### Health, Safety, & Nutrition

#### Child Care Food Program

A USDA Program that reimburses Child Care Providers for the healthy meals they serve to the children in their care

#### Trustline & Live Scan Fingerprint Services

Background checks and fingerprint services are available to local businesses, Child Care Providers, and families

#### EMSA Certified Preventative Health & Safety

We host the EMSA Certified Preventative Health and Safety course required for participants who are looking to obtain a Child Care License
