### WHAT IS SNCS?

Sierra Nevada Children's Services (SNCS) is a private, community-based nonprofit childcare Resource and Referral, and Alternative Payment Program agency that has served families, early care and education professionals and the community since 1978. We have 3 offices in Nevada and Sierra Counties – Grass Valley, Truckee, and Loyalton.



### SNCS MISSION STATEMENT

Sierra Nevada Children's Services enriches the community by supporting quality child care and empowering families to aspire to life-long success.



#### CHILDCARE SUBSIDY:

Assists eligible families with childcare costs while they work, job hunt, attend school, or recover from incapacity through using state and county funding.

#### Individuals Served in Fiscal Year 2023-2024:

**555** Families received subsidized child care through SNCS.

**683** Parents were able to be employed or educated, or other need met.

**843** Children received quality child care through our subsidy programs.



#### RESOURCE & REFERRAL:

Guides parents in finding childcare and community resources tailored to their needs, supports providers through the licensing process, and creates free Referral Profiles to connect providers with families seeking care.



#### CHILDCARE QUALITY IMPROVEMENT:

Offers professional development, training, technical and financial assistance. Provides health and safety incentives and other resources for childcare providers.

#### FOSTER BRIDGE:

Services are available for children in foster care or with a parent in foster care, offering navigation, enhanced childcare access, application assistance, and resource connections to support informed decisions and long-term childcare planning.



#### CHILD CARE INITIATIVE PROJECT (CCIP):

Expands family childcare by supporting licensing, startup costs, incentives, and professional development of in-home providers.



#### FAMILY CHILD CARE EDUCATION NETWORK:

Supports eligible families by providing subsidized child care in high quality family child care homes. The Network program is an alternative to center-based care, with the goal of achieving educational and developmental outcomes and desired results for families and children in a family child care environment.



#### CHILDREN'S COMMUNITY CHEST:

Provides funds for urgent needs like eviction prevention, utility payments, car repair, and summer camps when no other resources are available.



#### CRAIG PHILLIPS LEARNING CENTER (TLC):

TLC offers a Lending Library and Play Space with STEAM and age-appropriate materials, along with facilitated playgroups teaching interactive play techniques for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers.

#### Individuals Participated in TLC During Fiscal Year 2023-2024:

**879** Children attended playgroups, including Play and Learn, Kids Cooking Class, and Music for Littles.

**1,530** Families visited TLC for open playtime, where children engaged in creative and educational play.

**1,021** Educational items were checked out from our three lending library locations (Grass Valley, Truckee, & Loyalton).



SNCS also offers a range of health and safety resources, including free COVID-19 tests, Narcan spray, first aid kits, and CPR training. Preventative Health and Safety trainings offered to providers in Alpine, Colusa, El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sutter, and Yuba Counties.
