Services & Resources for Solano County Parents/Guardians

- **Help with Paying for Child Care:** We offer financial assistance to parents in Solano County to pay for child care while they work, go to school, look for work, etc. This assistance is essential to a healthy economy.
- **Resource & Referral Program:** We provide valuable information and referrals to all families, regardless of income, including support for finding child care, school readiness programs, services for children with special needs, and connections to community resources.
- **Help Me Grow Solano Program:** Our Family Navigators connect parents to essential services and resources in Solano County, offering free developmental screenings, connections to early childhood resources, basic needs assistance, parenting support, mental health services, and more, with follow-up to ensure families are connected to services.
- **Giving Closet:** We offer gently used clothing, shoes, blankets, and diapers for children ages 0-5 —while supplies last.

Services & Resources for Child Care Providers & Future Child Care Providers

- **Child Care Provider Trainings & Resources:** We assist individuals through the licensing process, we offer professional development for child care providers, including free training through the Child Care Initiative Project (CCIP) and monthly networking events to share best practices and business strategies.
- **Child & Adult Care Food Program (CACFP):** A USDA food and nutrition program that supports child care providers by reimbursing them for offering nutritious meals and snacks, ensuring healthy options for the children in their care.
- **TrustLine & Live Scan Fingerprint Services:** We provide fingerprinting services for background checks for prospective child care providers.


