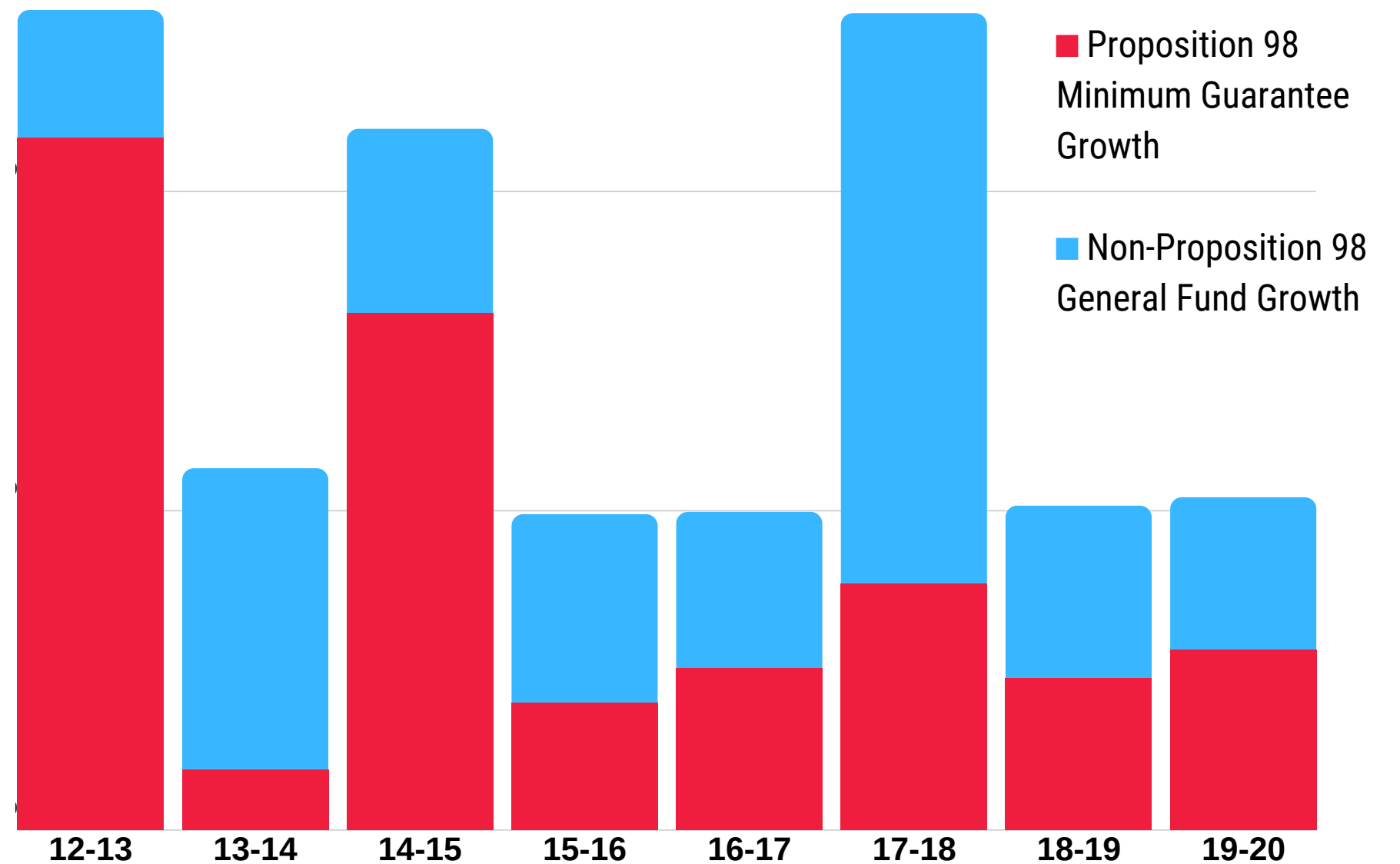

# BUDGET BACKGROUND

*The Budget is centered on making necessary investments for an effective government, promoting affordability and opportunity, and supporting just and dignified treatment for all Californians.*

- Budget surplus of \$21.4 billion
- Proposition 98/Non-Proposition 98 General Fund

# GOVERNOR'S BUDGET PROPOSALS

## STATE PRESCHOOL

State Preschool for all income eligible 4-year-olds by 2021-22

**\$297.1 million**

Shift part-day and full-day funding for non-LEAs to non-Proposition 98

**\$124.9 million**

Add 10,000 slots for non-LEAs

Eliminate work requirement for full-day care

## QUALITY

**\$10 million**

Blueprint

**\$245 million**

Workforce development

**\$245 million**

Infrastructure

**\$119.4 million**

CalWORKs adjustments

**\$39.7 million**

Full-year implementation reimbursement rate

# OTHER AGENCY PROPOSALS

Increase CalWORKs grant levels

Increase funding for local child support agencies

Expand Paid Family Leave

Expand access to Child Savings Accounts

Expand home visiting services

Increase adverse childhood experiences and developmental screenings

New Cal Grant access awards

CSU infrastructure funding that can be used for child care
